Leverage here means tools that amplify innate passions, unlocking breakthroughs in focus and creativity. Research from sources like Consumer Reports and Parents magazine highlights sensory toys for brain connections, while attachment studies emphasize proximity for emotional resilience. Non-obvious selections avoid generic rattles, favoring science-backed designs. For instance, visual tools like high-contrast mobiles stimulate the retina's development, forming eye-brain links essential for all learning.
